### **Dr. David Reagan**

Dr. David R. Reagan is my friend. He has supported the ministries of Candlelight for many years and has been a semi-frequent guest here at the church. I am thankful to have him here today.

For several years David showed himself to be the man I always believed him to be—when tirelessly nursing his wife until the day she graduated into eternity. For this I give God praise.

Several months later, God brought David together with a lovely woman who had herself been widowed. They had been friends for many earlier years. David founded Lamb & Lion Ministries on April 1, 1980 but has recently retired from full time service. Nonetheless, he continues writing, speaking, and washing the feet of men like me.

Dr. Reagan is a native Texan who resides in a suburb of Dallas. He is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of the University

of Texas in Austin. His graduate degrees were earned in the field of International Relations from the Fletcher School of Law & Diplomacy of Tufts and Harvard Universities.

Before entering the ministry, he had an extensive career in higher education which included the following positions: Assistant to the President of Austin College in Sherman, Texas; President of South Texas Jr. College in Houston; Director of Pepperdine University's Center for International Business in Los Angeles; and Vice President of Phillips University in Enid, Oklahoma.

In the mid-'60s David served as a Fulbright Lecturer at the University of the Philippines and toured all of Southeast Asia lecturing on U.S. foreign policy on behalf of the U.S. Information Agency.

David is a life-long Bible student, teacher, and preacher. He entered the full-time ministry in 1976 when he was called to serve as the pulpit minister for a church in Irving, Texas. His ordination as a Christian minister has been formally recognized by three different Christian groups.

Many of his religious essays have been published in a wide variety of journals and magazines. He has written 17 books, his newest being "America's Suicide." He has also

contributed to many others. His books have been translated into several languages.

David's sermons have been distributed worldwide. He has led 45 pilgrimages to Israel that focus on the prophetic significance of the sites visited. He has also conducted prophecy conferences in Russia, Poland, Hungary, the Czech Republic, Austria, Belarus, Israel, South Africa, Mexico, the Philippines, India, England (including Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland), and China.
