Luis was born in Mexico City into a Christian family; he committed his life to the Lord when he was a teenager and soon after became well involved in local ministries and outreaches. When he was 25, he felt strongly called to do full-time ministry, renouncing his formal work as a Professional government worker to start missionary training with Etnhos360 in Mexico. After he finished and on his very first visit to the US, he came up to North Idaho in order to learn English so He could go to Tanzania as a long-term missionary.

Vanessa came to the Lord when she was a kid; unfortunately, her family never took her back to Church again. As a young adult, she studied and ran her own business, pursuing success in life. It was when she met some indigenous kids that she realized there was no better help than the eternal salvation that comes from God. God used those kids to bring her back to Church and eventually enroll in missionary training. Luis and Vanessa met at the missionary training center in Mexico and married in 2014. By June 2017, they left Mexico to start a new journey in Tanzania. Through their many experiences, God has, in a myriad of His wonderful ways, showed them his love, provision, direction and unlimited grace, so they can continue to reach the unreached tribes in Africa.

They have developed their ministry from 3 different fronts:

- Mobilization Raising awareness about global missions among the Local Churches in Tanzania, so they can become a missionary-sending nation to bless the Nations.
- 2. **Discipleship Training** Equipping and empowering Africans so they can serve God and minister to others with a better preparation in the scriptures.
- 3. Church Planting There are a total of 120 tribes in Tanzania. Many of them have been already reached, however there are still some tribes where the Gospel has yet to be heard. This is the case of **the Rangi tribe**, which is majorly 95% Muslim. The Lopezes moved permanently to live among them last year in 2023.
